ARCHEOLOGICAL FINDS PROVE BIBLICAL EVENTS by Roberta D'Amico

On Saturday, February 23, 2013, Redemption Gate Mission Society hosted an amazing seminar featuring the latest discoveries of Biblical archeology. The seminar, held at Calvary's Love Church in Springfield MA, featured Kevin Fisher with Ark

Discovery International, located in Nashville, Tennessee. The program presented archeological evidence for important Biblical events that God is revealing to people for the approaching end of this age.

Kevin Fisher narrated the program, which included photos,

videos, and news stories of the late Ron Wyatt and his colleagues' work. Ron Wyatt studied and traveled to the Middle East for many years excavating Biblical, historical, and archeological finds. He realized that some people have known about Noah's Ark for

centuries, as the Roman Historian, Josephus, wrote, that it was visible back in 90AD.



In 1987, Wyatt took his two teenage sons into Turkey in search of the site of the Ark. Following prayer God miraculously led them to anchor stones for ships, the remains of Noah's house and graveyard, and finally, the Ark itself. Visible since the earthquake of 1978, are the dimensions of the boat, the same as in the Bible. Upon further examination of the Ark's structure,

it was concluded to be an ancient man-made ship. In December of 1986, the Turkish officials and researchers determined that the boat was indeed Noah's Ark.

Fisher then presented Ron Wyatt giving scientific proof that Sodom and Gomorrah were actually destroyed by fire and brimstone. Another part of the presentation was the Red Sea Crossing. Wyatt and his crew photographed bones and chariot wheels at the Crossing site in the Gulf of Aquaba.

Fisher concluded the seminar showing Wyatt's work in Jerusalem where he testified to having found the long, lost Ark of the Covenant. He was able to find the post holes where the crosses stood, not on a hilltop as so often

depicted, but along the road. Underneath, he found a grotto, and behind it a wall hiding a cave. In this cave was the Ark, and above it, a crack in the rock from the earthquake that occurred when Jesus was crucified. Blood and water had dripped down through the rock onto the Ark, landing on the Mercy Seat. Wyatt took a sample of the dry blood to a lab for testing. To their astonishment, they found that not only was the blood still alive, but it contained only 24 chromosomes, 23 from the mother, and only one 'Y' chromosome from God His Father.

FOLLOWING GOD'S PLAN WITH PASTOR SCOTT by Roberta D'Amico

On, February 15, 2013, Pastor Scott and Anne Lively returned from their long trip. They had left on December 26, 2012, with a plan, but it soon became apparent that our sovereign God had a different plan.

The highlight of the trip was a scheduled debate on February 1st at Oxford University in London, England. However, after their flights were booked, they found out the debate had actually taken place at a previous date. Unable to rearrange their travel plans, Scott and Anne still had 4 days in England.

Pastor Scott and Anne met with an Anglican group of mainstream conservative activists. Prophecy is difficult for the English because the Anglican Church is amillenial, and at the same time, gay marriage was being voted on in England, giving Scott the opportunity to explain how it ties into end times. Out of this, God gave them the idea to have a two-week residential retreat seminar to boost the pro-family movement in

England. God gave them a strategy involving the coming 800th Anniversary of the Magna Carta. The Magna Carta is the first modern document which recognizes both human rights and the right of churches to be free of government control.

Before their time in England, on board a cruise ship to Hawaii, Pastor Scott and Anne were given the opportunity to lead a morning Bible Study. This led to Pastor Scott preaching at two Sunday services. He taught the Coffee House style: Holy Spirit led, simple, informal with discussion format. The attendance grew to 150 people. This was God's plan!

Pastor Scott and Anne then went to Israel. They had planned to do ministry work there, looking up leaders, and identifying pro-family people. Instead, they spent 8 days in their room both with pneumonia. Scott said, "God allowed it, so it was for our good." "It was a lot of work," Scott said, "but a wonderful trip!"
