The MCFL event drew 600 people who came to enjoy the delicious dinner, hear the special speaker, Dr. Theresa Burke founder of Rachel's Vinevard, and honor the winners of the Prolife Awards.

As Pro-Lifers, we want to save babies and help men and women who have experienced abortion. Dr. Burke presented slides of how Rachel's Vineyard offers weekend which provides retreats supportive environment to begin process of restoration, renewal, and healing for those suffering the effects of postabortion. Pro-lifers are often portrayed as being anti-women. Actually, we boldly proclaim the truth that abortion hurts women, fathers, and grandparents. 
