Preparations continue for Saturday, August 17th event!



On July 11, 2013, most of the Team Leaders for the Convoy of Hope gathered at the Riverfront Park. Elaine Walker led the meeting, encouraging all of us by sharing about all the donations that have been received, both monetary and merchandise.

Each Team Leader then gave a status report; some had superb organizational materials to share concerning where they were in their planning, others just mentioned their needs, especially for volunteers. By sharing, we were able to see the "holes" in our plans, particularly the logistics of the setup, like the necessity of moving the groceries give-away to a better location. The Shoe Giving has been moved to the southern end of the park, where we measured off exactly where it would be set up.

The biggest needs now are to get the rest of the volunteers, especially for the Kids zone and some skilled people for specialized areas. Helpers are also needed to unload and move the groceries. Finally, there are still needs for funds and supplies.

Where are we now on the plan to bless Springfield and reach out to all with the message that Jesus Christ loves them? We will be offering the expected 5000 guests a referral to the local participating churches. It is exciting to know that they will be followed up concerning their spiritual needs.

All team leaders and staff participants have a sense of the spiritual value of the project.







Everyone is enthusiastic about the project being "all about God". He even held back the rain that had been forecasted. One leader offered the suggestion that we make it a matter of prayer daily, by picking a time, either 6:15 am, 12:15 pm, or 6:15 pm and pray for the success of the Convoy. "I loved the prayer time idea. What better way to come together than to pray at those hours, knowing that others will be praying together with you," said Pastor Cooley.
