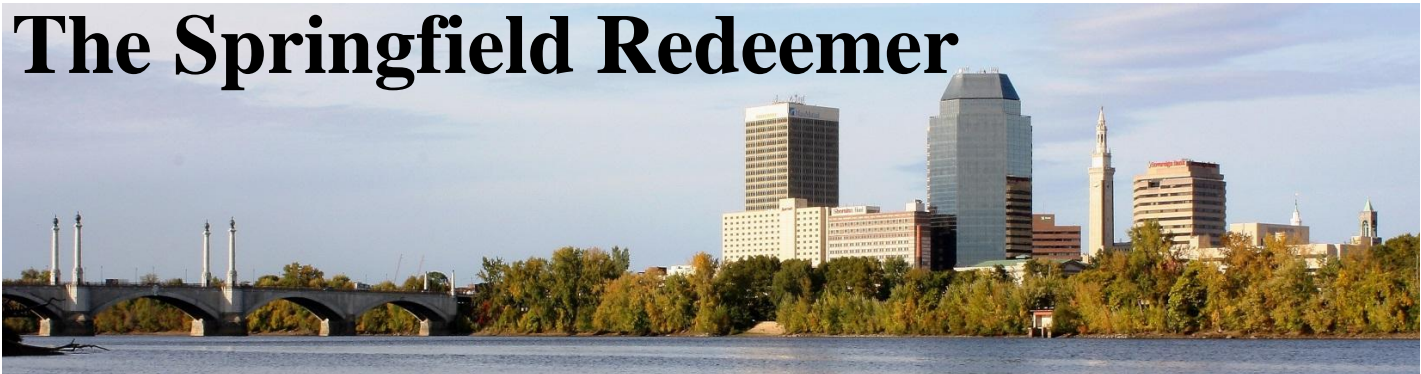

Transformation Centered Healing Ministries under the leadership and guidance of Eric and Susan Thomas hosted this event to foster love, and support physical and social change, in the Springfield area - with a strong focus on empowering couples, single parents, and single individuals seeking relationships.



Saturday the primary presenter was Pastor Susan Thomas, who presented working definitions for relationships, family and the roles therein. The slideshow presentation provided great visuals for her detailed narrative. Pastor Susan

encouraged attendees to embrace both pastoral and professional counseling to reveal and heal relationship challenges.

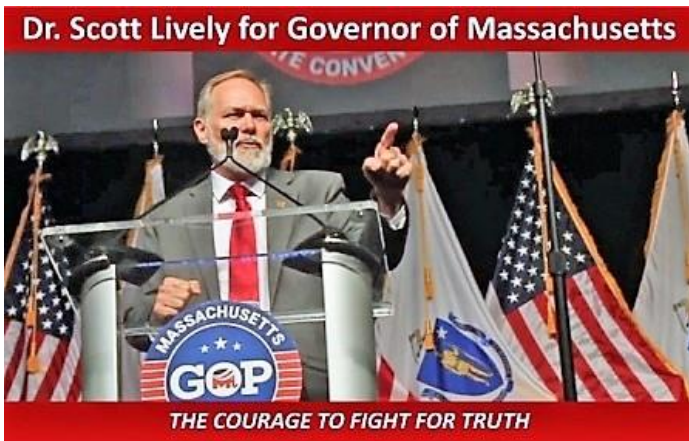

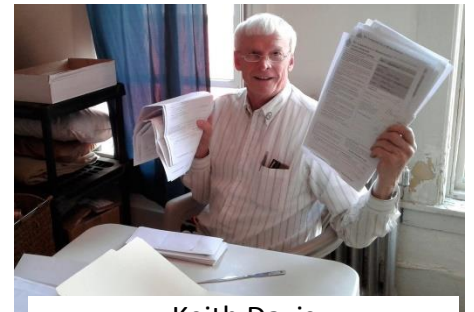
Scott Lively Successful at Republican Convention

On April 28, 2018, Pastor Scott Lively, who was praying for the needed 15% of the delegate votes at the Republican Convention, Worcester DCU Center, walked away with a surprising 27%, shocking everyone!

A number of us from the Coffee House were at the convention, sharing in the excitement, serving as delegates, supporting Scott and collecting signatures for his nomination papers. This is one of the more difficult

tasks in becoming a candidate, but all through the last couple of months the faithful volunteers have been collecting signatures at churches, shopping centers, and events throughout the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. The count has not been finalized but it stands at more than the required 10,000! This qualifies Scott Lively to be on the ballot for governor in the primary in September. All praise to God.
