

entrepreneurial projects, and a venue for larger groups to meet, plus a second Coffee House.

The Tag Sale is one of many projects and events we held to raise awareness and support, both prayer



and financial, for our efforts to make Springfield a better, safer, and a more Godly place. It went very well. We sold

dogs, chips, soda, along with desserts.

The fellowship among all who volunteered and who attended was so sweet, as it always is when the church comes together to serve. Jackie had her own "corner" with many beautiful hats and dresses for sale. There were also baby clothes and uniforms. A special blessing was that we were able to pray with any of the folks there who had a need.

As a result \$400 was raised for the Coffee House 2 project. October marked the end of the first year of fund raising for the project. The Project was called The *12 Tribes of Israel \$500 Challenge*, and it worked like this: Twelve leaders were chosen and each picked a name of one of the Tribes of Israel (named after the 12 sons of Jacob who headed the tribes in the Exodus from Egypt.) Then each supporter chose a tribe and donated to that Tribe's fund. Each Tribe endeavored to raise \$500 a month for 12 months, recording it on their worksheet. All the money raised this year was deposited into a special account.

So, including the money from the Tag Sale, \$12,000 was raised the first year. Going forward, the

plan is to include some big musical events, working with LoveJoy concerts, with \$20 -\$25 tickets, raising possibly \$25,000. The Tribes Funding Project will also continue for the next 12 months.

We hope to



have the first Concert of 3 prospective concerts in December of this year, coordinating with the Christmas season.
