As a result, Pastor, along with Daniel Torres and others from the Pastors' and Leaders' Prayer Group, called Mission Pioneer Valley, planned gatherings for prayer, inviting all churches of any color or nationality to come together. A highlight of this first gathering on June 2, 2020,on City Hall steps, was praying over the Mayor, especially for wisdom and unity! September brought a second Prayer Meeting at Bethany AG Church, uniting many local churches which took part. Now, in the beginning of 2022, we held the 7th Unity Prayer Service!

Together we lifted up our hearts in Thanksgiving for the faithfulness of our God, and His loving gift of salvation based on Ephesians 2:8-9. Between prayers we sang worship songs, with the

"To rightly understand God's will and God's ways, we need sound minds," Pastor Vasily said. "The
