~ Denise's Testimony ~

Note: Denise O'Connor has been coming to the Holy Grounds Coffee House at least a year. She

is one of many volunteers who donates her time and energy to this ministry, making it possible

for Holy Grounds to keep on serving the people of Springfield. Here is her testimony in her own

words: I want to tell you what the Coffee House Ministry has meant in my life. I have been a Christian for a long time, knowing the Lord and loving the Lord. But things have changed for me since I started coming to the Coffee House about a year ago.

We gather for Bible Study in the morning, five days a week, for at least an hour, led by one of three different pastors who take turns teaching. The people sitting at this table are people truly seeking God. When God's people get together daily to seek Him, you can sense God's Presence in this place.

Being here has helped me grow tremendously in the knowledge of God. We read the Scripture and take notes and then after, I'll read the notes I've taken. Sometimes after the Study we will discuss the Scriptures with one another. Through this studying, I've come closer to God. My understanding of Him has increased.

It's different than your home church, very different, because it's not just a church. Actually it is

a church, but it doesn't feel like a church. There is a freedom to get up and get coffee, to speak or not



to speak. We are not hearing a sermon, we are a sermon, we live the sermon. Everyone in a conversation anywhere in the building is a message for all.

Possibly the largest issue I've had in my life was fear, fear of rejection, fear of not being liked. The Bible Study has helped me recognize this. Now I know that God is pleased with me. No matter what I say or what I do, if my heart is to please God, He is pleased with me. I actually always knew that, but it is more real to me now. I feel more empowered to just love God more publicly,

and not always verbally, but just more openly, with a freedom from fear, a freedom from concern of rejection.

I also work at the Coffee House, at the counter. It is such a blessing to chat with the people who come in, to pray with some, to talk about who God is and what His Word says. I get to communicate with lots of different people. I've learned to be a lot more accepting of people, those who do the right things, and some who don't do the right things. Through the eyes of God, I've learned to love them, accept them, without judgment, the way God does.

I just love coming here. I love all the people here. I feel at home, well-loved, accepted, like I'm really living. Even though I don't get paid in money, I get so many blessings. I come here because the Spirit of the Lord is here and I can't help but have a desire to come here, to be where the Spirit is.
