Why Should Christians Celebrate Hanukkah?

Christmas Eve, This year Hanukkah, an eight-day Jewish celebration, begins on December 24th! This awesome story of God's plan for His Kingdom happened during those 400 years between the close of the Old Testament as we know it today and the birth of Jesus. In the 2nd century before Christ, Israel was ruled and cruelly oppressed by Antiochus Epiphanes, the Syrian king. He forced the Greek and Syrian idol-worship and customs on God's people and many Jews were martyred.

An old priest, Mattityahu, and his followers fled to the hills of Judea, determined to remain loyal to God. They fought the Syrians from there and after many battles, miraculously defeated the 40,000-man army. Having liberated Jerusalem, they cleansed the Temple, built a new altar, and made a new Menorah, thereby defeating another of Satan's attempts to destroy God's chosen people and prevent the Messiah from coming!

Then another miracle – they had oil enough for



the menorah only for one day, and it would take eight days to get more. But God made

the oil last for the whole eight days. The celebration of Hanukkah, also called Feast of Lights or Dedication, developed to commemorate this event. So Hanukkah celebrates God's supplying the oil, a "shadow" of Christ, the Light of the World, His provision of our needs, and the preservation of the Messianic line of Christ our Savior.
